A portion of every team's registration fee goes to support the Charlotte Local Education Foundation's highly acclaimed local educational mentoring and scholarship program.

A team consists of 20 paddlers, 4 alternates, and 1 drummer. At least 16 paddlers plus 1 drummer are required on a boat at race time. Paddlers must be equally divided between male and female. Professional steerspersons are provided.
